As our Annual Meeting approaches, I have been asked to provide the logistics of the meeting. It will look different again this year as we continue to deal with COVID and the challenges it requires of us all.

Our Annual Meeting will follow our 9 am service February 13th. As usually, we ask you to social distance, do not come if you are ill, and wear a mask if you choose or if you are not fully vaccinated and have not had your booster shot. No refreshments will be served, so feel free to bring your coffee thermos or a bottle of water. A Zoom alternative will be provided. The address to enter the Zoom meeting is listed and will be sent prior to the meeting. You will receive a copy of the Annual Report in hard copy format through the mail and online two weeks before the meeting. Financials will not be included with the online version. Monica will have extra copies in the office if you need one. Included in the report will be an outline of the meeting, committee reports, financial information, and ballots to vote on the final altar renovation, a Constitution and bylaw amendment, and our OCWM contributions. Presently, we feel we have not gathered enough information to vote on a plan for Zwingli. The cemetery may be a topic of discussion if additional information is obtained from a legal source. We have big decisions to make. We will however, persevere, "always forward" with the spiritual guidance and grace of our membership.

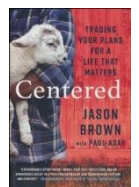

Confirmation






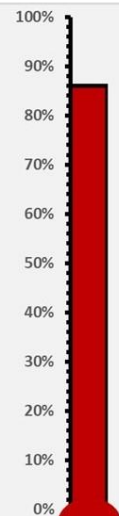

North Stairway Closed

The outdoor steps leading up to the church from 4th Avenue will be CLOSED starting November 15th through April 15th. The stairwell is closed during the winter to protect the steps from damage caused by salt and to protect you from a potential injury. We ask that you do not bypass them. The church is closed for now but should it reopen we graciously ask that you adhere to this message. The entrances on the North and South side should be used when services resume.



Winter Weather Reminder

Brace yourself, winter is here and with it comes snow, ice, and below zero temperatures including severe wind chill factors. This means hazardous travel and exposure to extreme frostbite. To ensure the safety of our members, the Swiss UCC Church **will cancel** worship service and Sunday school classes when weather officials announce a “winter weather advisory or warning” with travel not advised. This includes a wind chill temperature of minus 25/30 degrees.



A general rule of thumb is to use extreme caution when large amounts of snow/ice are predicted. Extremely low temperatures plus a wind chill factor make for dangerous situations. Falling can be just as fatal as driving so please don't go out unless you know it's safe.

To determine whether Swiss UCC Church worship services and Sunday school classes are cancelled, check:

Our Church's Wider Mission (OCWM) One Great Hour of Sharing

The OCWM provides funding from congregations for Conferences and the national ministries of the United Church of Christ (Wider Church Ministries, Local Church Ministries, Justice and Witness Ministries, General Ministries, and Pension Boards).

The OCWM has five offerings in 2022. There is the One Great Hour of Sharing (fourth Sunday of Lent on March 27, 2022); Strengthen the Church (Pentecost Sunday on June 5, 2022); Neighbors in Need (First Sunday in October on Oct. 2, 2022); Stewardship Sunday (Nov. 13, 2022); and the Christmas Fund (the Sunday before Christmas on Dec. 18, 2022).

In March, offerings for “One Great Hour of Sharing” will be on **March 27, 2022**. Through this offering, the UCC collaborates with domestic and international partners to support humanitarian aid and sustainable development, bringing needed assistance to communities in need of long-term recovery and economic sustainability. Gifts also provide much needed resources to assist in providing clean water, food, education, health care, small business micro-credit, emergency relief, advocacy, and resettlement for refugees.

Normally, the church would have envelopes available in the church, however due to the limited number of members able to attend in person and others attending through the online sermons, envelopes will be in the church sanctuary and some in the mailbox located by the church office. Offerings can be left in these envelopes OR you can use your own envelope. Be sure to write **OCWM-One Hour** on the front of the envelope.
