A Message from Our Pastor, Pat Pluss ...

I have in my office a "Grab n Go" bag of M&M's. It is not very big, 5 oz, I thought for sure it was just a one-time serving bag and I planned on consuming it in one sitting. But when I read the nutrition facts on the back of it, I found out it contains 5 servings! Each serving is about 32 individual M&M's. I



counted out 32, that didn't seem like a serving to me. . . when it comes to candy and desserts my self-control seems to be lacking.

I am pretty sure if you asked the people closest to me, they could think of other areas I could use a bit more self-control. Most of us can probably identify at least one area where we could exercise more self-control if we're being honest. Common areas where self-control is often lacking include one's temper, spending habits, time management, commitment to daily devotions, work ethic, choice of words, and how one spends their free time. The list could go on and on.

The struggle with self-control is introduced early in the scriptures. Adam and Eve's sin in the Garden of Eden stemmed from a lack of self-control in resisting the devil's temptation. Jesus emphasizes the necessity of self-control in Matthew 16:24 "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me."

Practicing self-control involves aligning our choices with God's will. Randy Frazee, an author and pastor, writes, "Self-control is not only about the discipline to stop doing things that destroy us but also about the discipline to do the things that build us up."

Self-control includes daily choices and long-term objectives. It's about saying no when we're tempted to say yes, declaring enough when we desire more, and sometimes mustering the willpower to do what's best. For Christians, God provides his assistance through the Holy Spirit. We can seek God's aid in areas where our strength falls short. Even on days when we lack self-control, God's love remains plentiful, and it's comforting to know He extends His support through His Spirit.

As for the M&M's I only had 32, this time...

Swiss UCC Consistory Meeting Minutes April 24, 2024

Meeting called to order by Kim Bright at 6:32 p.m. Pat Pluss led us in prayer.

There being no objections, the consent agenda to approve the March minutes, treasurer's report, and approval of checks written was moved by Kim Bright, seconded by Rachel Baker. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report

Total income for March was \$30,268, which included a transfer from Planned Giving in the amount of \$2498(to cover recording fees for the last few months of 2023) was \$892 over budget. Actual offerings were \$27,628 in March which was the largest amount given in a month for the last two years excluding Decembers. March did have five Sundays plus Easter this year. Income YTD is \$75,583 compared to a budgeted income of \$66,855. Expenses were also under budget by \$1719 for a net income of \$17,764.

As of March 31, the General Fund had a cash balance of \$97,147, operating reserve account of \$55,471 and a CD for \$50,902.

The only unbudgeted expense in March was the clock motor for \$514.

Heading into the summer/travel months with a nice cushion!

Kim Bright moved that some money in the General Fund be moved into a Money Market account; Nicole Bidwell seconded. Motion carried.

Heidi Salzman moved to authorize the Executive Committee to approve what direction Marlis Silver selects for an accounting system if further information is available before the next Executive Committee meeting; Nicole Sidwell seconded. Motion carried.

Pastoral Report

May 19, we will honor those graduating students of Swiss Church who wish to be recognized in worship. Each will receive a small gift.

When you log in, you use your password (the first verification) and a unique code sent to your email or phone (the second verification) to ensure it's really you.

- 1. Protects Your Data: Further safeguards sensitive information like contact information and financial records.
- 2. Prevents Unauthorized Access: Adds a powerful layer against cyber threats to your Realm account.
- 3. Strengthens Trust: Shows our commitment to keeping your information secure and the confidentiality of data and resources.

Please enable two-step verification for your Realm account by following these steps:

- Configure your verification methods (email/mobile number).
 - 1. Click your name in the top right corner of the screen.
 - 2. Select **My Account** from the drop-down menu. You will be prompted to sign in again for security reasons.
 - 3. Select which method of verification you want to enable.
