### **Confirmation Class Starts in October!**

It is time to start thinking about Confirmation Class again! Confirmation Class will be a collaboration of educational teachings, volunteerism, working with a mentor, mission work, and more.

#### Our goals are:

- To teach a basic understanding of the Christian Faith – emphasis on loving God and loving others.
- To teach a basic understanding of the Bible
- To teach a basic understanding of the church and its outreach
- Build lasting relationships with each other and mentors

This is a two-year program for students in 7th and 8th grade. Exceptions are made for students who would like to join who are beyond those years in school. We meet the first Wednesday of the month with an adult mentor (the student and family will choose the mentor) and a second time in the month on varying dates, where usually a special meeting takes place.

\* Second year students are asked to confirm their mentor is able to join them this year.

Students <u>new to the program</u> should contact Pastor Pat or the church office at (608)527-2119 and registration forms will be mailed.

Our first meeting is Wednesday, October 2nd 6pm-7:30pm. Parents of the students will be asked to provide a simple meal for our Wednesday meetings. The confirmation meeting schedule will be mailed out, along with the schedule of the families in charge of the meals for each month.

Regular church attendance, along with attending the scheduled meetings held during the month for the confirmation class are required.

#### **Goals for Parents:**

- Think about your own relationship with God, your church experiences, and your faith and share these with your child;
- Be open to questions that your child might have during their confirmation journey;

 Treat Confirmation as you would school, sports, music or art activities, and encourage and support your child in the Confirmation process.

A new NIV study Bible will be presented in worship on Sunday, September 29 -9am. Students will use the Bible at their Wednesday meetings. We are grateful for the support of this program by the weekly giving of the confirmation parents and congregation! # Swiss UCC Consistory Meeting Minutes June 26, 2024

The meeting was called to order by Kim Bright at 6:35. Pat Pluss led us in an opening prayer. Items added to the agenda

- Cemetery meeting scheduled by the Village

Chris Kiesz moved to approve the amended agenda; Rachel Baker seconded. Motion carried.

#### Consent Agenda

With the deletion of one paragraph in the May minutes, the consent agenda to approve the May minutes, Treasurer's Report, and checks written was made by Jon Ziltner; seconded by Rachel Baker. Motion carried.

#### Treasurer's Report for Financial Statements ending May 31, 2024

Income for May was \$20,305 and expenses were \$20,223 for a net gain of \$82. Year to date income is \$111,348 and expenses are \$95,705 leaving a net profit of \$15,643. Income for 2024 is \$7,543 over budget and expenses are \$2,311 under budget resulting in net income \$9,854 above budgeted projections.

The only expense in May that was significantly over budget was the account for computer fees for \$1,518. The annual renewal fee for QB was \$949, annual payroll fee of \$474 plus the normal check deposit fees were paid in May.

Cemetery had income of \$181 and expenses of \$1535 for a cash decrease of \$1354. Cemetery savings and checking account balances are now at \$19,456. Market value of the Cemetery Perpetual Care Fund is \$119,578. as of May 31, 2024.

- Jon Ziltner evaluated Marlis' job performance. Her summer project is to update an emergency handbook for use should she become incapacitated for a lengthy period of time.
- Pat Pluss will review Diane Elmer's job performance in July.
- Zwingli House discussions will continue in July.

#### New Business

- Kim move to reimburse Ben Bedward \$308 for two pieces of equipment with funding to be decided by Jon Ziltner and Marlis Silver; Heidi Mondloch seconded. Motion carried.
- Chris Kiesz moved to pay Ryan Zimmerman \$850 from the cemetery fund for cleanup of a tree that had fallen on gravestones during a recent storm; Jessica Swan seconded. Motion carried.
- Jessica Swan has begun the process of Safe Sanctuary protocols and will report back in July.
- Kim Bright will contact Wirth Landscaping regarding trimming of the cemetery.

The Executive Committee will confirm checks written in July by email during week 2. A combined Executive/Consistory meeting will be on July 24.

A meeting with the Village on the cemetery transfer is being scheduled. Members include Kim Bright, Gof Thompson, Larry Stuessy, and Kristina Schneider.

Rachel Baker moved to adjourn; Gary Krahenbuhl seconded. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:46 p.m.
